**VCF is committed to the promotion and development of volunteering to benefit the people of Fenland – working with individuals and community groups, as well as voluntary and statutory agencies by providing:**

- Brokerage (matching volunteers to volunteer organisations);
- Promoting volunteering both for the individual and the community;
- Development of best practice and ways of reaching and supporting volunteers of all backgrounds and abilities;
- Supporting organisations in identifying / developing new opportunities for individuals of all backgrounds and abilities;
- Contributing to policy responses and campaigning
- Contributing to the strategic development of volunteering through the Cambridgeshire & Peterborough Network of Volunteer Centres;
- VCF is funded by the County Council; the Town Councils of Chatteris, March and Whittlesey; and other funding sources i.e. the Big Lottery (Awards for All).
- Promoting and contributing to the Annual Valuing Volunteering Awards, and the Five Star Focus on Excellence in organisations that offer volunteering opportunities.

**VCF administers the National Do-It Be More website for the whole district of Fenland, providing nearly 1,000 volunteering opportunities for nearly 200 organisations in and around Chatteris; March; Whittlesey; Wisbech; and the villages and parishes throughout the district.**
